

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 17-1324

Being a by-law to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute a purchase agreement with Carrier Centers Inc. for an Initial Attack Fire Vehicle for the Temagami Fire Department.

WHEREAS under Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly to enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS under Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS under Section 10 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

AND WHEREAS on the 12th day of January, 2017 the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami passed Resolution 17-015 directing staff to initiate the purchase/ordering process with Carrier Centers Inc. to supply an Initial Attack Fire Vehicle, with an upset price of \$271,130.00 plus HST, for Council approval by by-law at a future council meeting;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A" to this bylaw.
2. That the Temagami Fire Chief is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections to Schedules "A" and "C" of the agreement that do not affect the price.
3. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to the by-law and schedule, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.
4. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.

BE TAKEN AS READ A FIRST time on this 2nd day of February 2017.

READ A SECOND AND THIRD time and finally passed this 2nd day of February 2017.
