

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI**

BY-LAW NO. 17-1332

Being a by-law to enter into a participant agreement with the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry with regard to the Central Ontario Orthophotography Project – 2016.

WHEREAS under Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly to enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS under Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS on the 23rd day of February 2017, Council received Memo 2017-M-027 regarding the Central Ontario Orthophotography Project – 2016 under the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry's Ontario Imagery Strategy;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality deems it desirable to enter into a participant agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario, as represented by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry for said project at a cost to the Municipality of \$4,249.12;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A" to this bylaw.
2. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
3. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to the by-law and schedule, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.

BE TAKEN AS READ A FIRST time on this 23rd day of February 2017.

READ A SECOND AND THIRD time and finally passed this 23rd day of February 2017.
