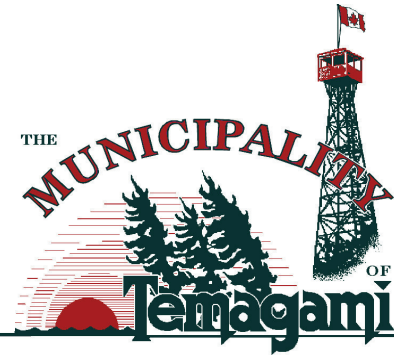

Re: Proposed Energy East Pipeline – Areas of Increased Concern

In 2014, TransCanada provided the Municipality of Temagami with information concerning the proposed Energy East pipeline and a map showing the route it will take. The Municipality has reviewed the information provided and would like to submit the following.

Please find attached, a document that shows areas that the Municipality considers to be vulnerable areas that are of increased concern. These areas consist of road crossings, water crossings and areas where the pipeline comes in close proximity to commercial and residential properties. Although any oil spill is considered to be a major concern for the Municipality and its residents, of particular importance are the areas that are adjacent to lakes used as source water for the two town sites, Temagami South and Temagami North, as well the water crossings in the Marten River Area.

The Municipality would like TransCanada to provide details of how they plan to ensure the condition of the pipes in the identified vulnerable areas, including the examination of the pipe prior to putting them into service for the Energy East Project, and the maintenance plan for the pipe once it is in service.

Council has expressed interest in having TransCanada make a presentation to Council regarding how the Municipality's interests will be addressed.
