### MONTHLY REPORT OCTOBER 2015--Report # 2015-056

#### **TRAINING**

- Oct 5<sup>th</sup> Fire fighters watched the CODE4 extrication video titled "Total Side Removal ". The extrication tools were taken from the trucks and Fire Chief Elliott discussed there uses and operations.
- Oct 26<sup>th</sup> The studded tires were installed on Rescue5. Inventory was completed for Rescue3 and Rescue5. SIR were completed and filed.

#### **INCIDENTS {7}**

- Oct 2<sup>nd</sup> A pickup truck vs bull moose collision on Highway 64 resulted in injuries to a youth.
- Oct 5<sup>th</sup> Members responded to a medical call involving a senior resident of Beaverland Road. Fire fighters monitored the patient's condition until EMS arrived.
- Oct 11<sup>th</sup> The department was dispatched to a forest fire on Pan Fish Lake. Members advised boaters to clear the area and monitored the situation until MNR crews arrived.
- Oct 18<sup>th</sup> A male senior visiting a residence on Beaverland Road collapsed. Fire fighters attached the AED and performed CPR until EMS arrived.
- Oct 19<sup>th</sup> The department was called out to a tree on powerline at the MTO rest area on Hwy 11 at Tilden Lake. The department was called off before leaving the fire hall.
- Oct 20<sup>th</sup> Fire fighters were dispatched to a medical for a female Bear Island resident traveling along Highway 11. Oxygen was administered and the patient monitored until EMS arrived.
- Oct 28<sup>th</sup> MRFD responded to a male with possible concussion at Land of Lakes Lodge. Fire fighters administered oxygen, completed first aid form and monitored the patient until EMS arrived
