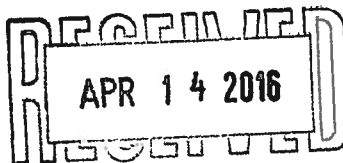

Today, the Honourable Deb Matthews, Minister Responsible for the Poverty Reduction Strategy, announced that Ontario's public benefit sector, including Indigenous organizations, can submit proposals for the second round of the Local Poverty Reduction Fund.

The Ontario Trillium Foundation is proud to partner with the Government of Ontario to administer the fund.

Organizations have until May 30, 2016 to register for the June 29, 2016, LPRF deadline. More information about the application process, timelines and resources is available on the **Local Poverty Reduction Fund** website.

Organization already registered and verified as eligible to apply for OTF grants are automatically registered and eligible to apply for the LPRF. Beginning May 30, 2016, LPRF applications will be available to those organizations in the OTF application portal. They will simply be given the ability to apply for the LPRF, as well as OTF grants.

OTF in collaboration with the Treasury Board Secretariat will host outreach sessions in April and May across Ontario to promote the Local Poverty Reduction Fund. Please visit the **Outreach Calendar** to register for an information session in your area.
